MELBOURNE NOTES

- For the second straight night, Melbourne's starter could not make it out of the fourth inning, as Phillies farmhand Josh Tols only pitched three innings, surrendering two earned runs on five hits and three walks, though he struck out four.
- Seven of the nine hitters in the Aces lineup recorded a hit for a total of nine, the second straight night at least 2/3 of the team's batters had a base knock.
- All six of Melbourne's batters who had hits last night also connected for a base hit today.
- For the second straight night, the Aces imports from Japan made a big offensive impact. Yuma Mune, Hayato Nishiura and Kodai Sano of NPB's Orix Buffaloes) combined to go 5-12. Mune now has two hits in each of his first two games.
- For the second straight night, **Delmon Young** drove in a run for the Aces, following up his home run last night with an RBI single, later scoring Melbourne's only other run of the game.

- After six Cavalry hitters recorded a base hit Thursday, including three multi-hit performances, the hot bats continued into Friday, with six more players reaching base via a hit, including a whopping five two-hit performances.
- **Gavin Cecchini** and **Cam Warner** both recorded multihit games for the second straight night, with Warner 6-8 to begin the 2019/20 season.
- Not only did Taylor Kohlwey hit his second home run in as many nights, Kyle Perkins connected for two of his own, driving in four runs on the evening for important insurance in the five-run win.
